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**Dental care:** Members under age 21 can receive all medically necessary dental services including cleanings, x-rays, fillings, crowns, and other services. Members over age 21 can receive dental services based on their Medical Assistance benefits package and medical need.

**Eye care:** Members under age 21 can get eye exams. Members over age 21 can receive eye care services based on their Medical Assistance benefits package and medical need.

**Prescription benefits:** Members can receive brand name and generic drugs, certain over the counter drugs and vitamins, insulin supplies, and vaccines based on their Medical Assistance benefits package.

**Other programs**

**Ask Me 3™** is available online and helps you make the most of your doctor's visit with three questions to ask your doctor at every visit.

**Case Management:** If you have special health care needs, our staff can help you stay well. They will work with your doctors to provide you service. They will help you set up a care plan that is right for you.

**Disease Management:** If you have asthma, chronic lung disease or diabetes, a registered nurse will answer your questions. The nurse will work with your doctors to help you stay healthy.

**Medline:** Have a question about your health? Medline is an online tool to help you get information.

**Member Services:** We are here 24 hours a day to help you with any questions you may have.

**Pregnant?** Get a free baby book about having a healthy baby. You may also talk with a nurse about your pregnancy.

**Prevention and Wellness programs** to help you stay healthy. This includes reminder cards to get your flu shot or your mammogram. If you have children, you may get reminders for your child's well-visit or shots. Provides information on how to stop smoking and other helpful subjects.

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**Other programs**

**Asian Community Resource Center** provides information, health education, and community programs in Chinese, Cantonese, Mandarin, Vietnamese, Cambodian and Laotian.

**Case Management** provides extra help for asthma, diabetes, heart disease, lead poisoning prevention, dental health and quitting smoking.

**Fitness:** Receive \$75 towards a YMCA membership at participating locations.

**Health-on-Wheels Tour:** This van offers screenings, health education and fun activities to members in the community.

**Healthy First Steps:** Works with you and your doctor to help you have a healthy baby. Rewards moms-to-be with diaper gift cards for going to prenatal visits.

**Home Doctor Visits** to members with chronic conditions.

**Member Appreciation Rewards** earn rewards for having routine exams and preventive health screenings.

**Tuition Assistance** provides you with a 10% to 25% tuition reduction at Drexel University's E-Learning Program.

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**Other programs**

**Focus on Kids' Health:** Children are offered educational materials for their age groups. Our quarterly newsletter "Bear Facts" gives educational health tips and community preventive care events.

**Health Education:** Members can visit [www.mycoventrycares.com](http://www.mycoventrycares.com) (My Online Services) to see a variety of health topics and hints for a healthy lifestyle. Health education events are also offered within the community.

**Help Getting Care:** Our case management team helps members manage asthma, COPD, diabetes, heart and other conditions. We address medical and social issues which prevent members from getting needed care, and coordinate referrals to community resources.

**Help with Special Needs** helps members take care of their health and get the care they need.

**Maternity Care – Bright Expectations:** Pregnant moms receive personal services to help them have a healthy and happy pregnancy. Home visits are provided to all pregnant moms after delivery to provide education and support. Moms who participate in this program and go to their doctor visits will receive a gift for mom and baby.

**Nurse Call Line** provides help and information 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

**Rewards for Child Exams:** Members receive gift cards for taking their children to all necessary preventive exams during the first year of life and through the teenage years.

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**Other programs**
